## EQUIPMENT

The tools utilized in this course are new technology and represent current rescue equipment available from fire/rescue equipment vendors. These include spreaders and cutters, airbags, struts, air chisels, hand tools, cribbing, and much more.

## **PPE – Turn out gear**

Firefighters must be equipped with appropriate PPE that meets WAC 296-305-02001, Personal Protective Equipment and Protective Clothing. Extrication PPE may be appropriate for some scenarios.

This sixteen (16) hour program was developed to provide realistic Advanced Auto Extrication training. The course will offer life like and challenging scenarios for you to respond to, take control and mitigate.

Topics covered include:

- \* NFPA Standards; 1001 Chapter 6 (6.4), 1006 Chapter 8, and 1670 Chapter 8, Ops. and Technician levels.

- \* Incident Command, Scene Control & Responder Safety.

- \* Auto Extrication, with and without Hydraulic Rescue Tools.

- \* Shoring, Airbags and stabilization

- \* Mitigating Hazardous Conditions
